We are planning a community-wide outreach for April 28, 2024, at Central Hardin High School. The theme is, "Let's Hope." Here is the tentative plan:

*Churches will gather in the respective stations to prepare hamburgers and hotdogs.

*Water bottles station. Churches providing water will gather. Each church will be responsible for providing the bottled water. *Games such as corn hole and others will be provided by volunteers at appropriate areas.

*Portal waste units and a dumpster will be available. Volunteers will be near the portal units with hand sanitizer to have Gospel conversations.

*Tables with chairs. We will leave up to individual churches per their respective display,

*Inflatables. Stithton will provide and volunteers from other churches will assist.

*Evangelistic and training for real life issues (grief and divorce and suicide), and invitation follow-up will occur monthly between now and the outreach. Kenny Rager and Brian Hinton will address the training needs.

*Review volunteer assistance expectations. We hope to have 150 volunteers from the 20 plus participating churches to assist with the crowd.

*Security. Each church will bring their team. We will meet and review security training prior to the event.

*Custodian charge for the ministry will be paid by the association

*The theme for the event, "Let' Hope" with the Scripture, 2 Corinthians 5:20. The purpose of the ministry is to show God's love, assist the lost to be reconciled to Christ, and to show that the local church is relevant. We want to serve the community.

*Team shirts. Each church will address their respective volunteer needs. Merrill Kurtz will be the contact person.

*Blood pressure screening, health care, and oxygen screening. We hope to provide these screenings.

*Other ministries will be offered as the Lord leads us during our meetings.

*Order of service for the event: Outside from 4:00-6:00 in the parking lot. The Band will begin playing from 6:00-6:30. Eric and Joe, 6:30-7:15, Kenny Rager, 7:15-7:30

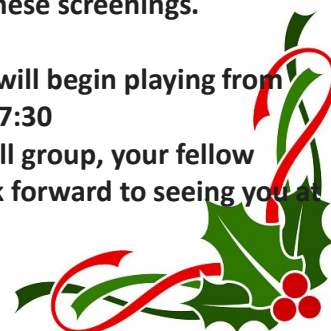

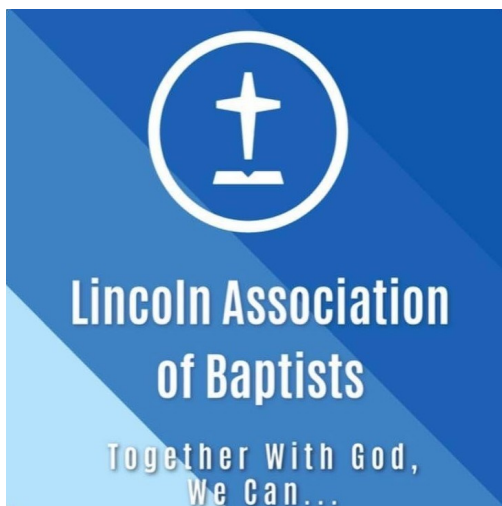
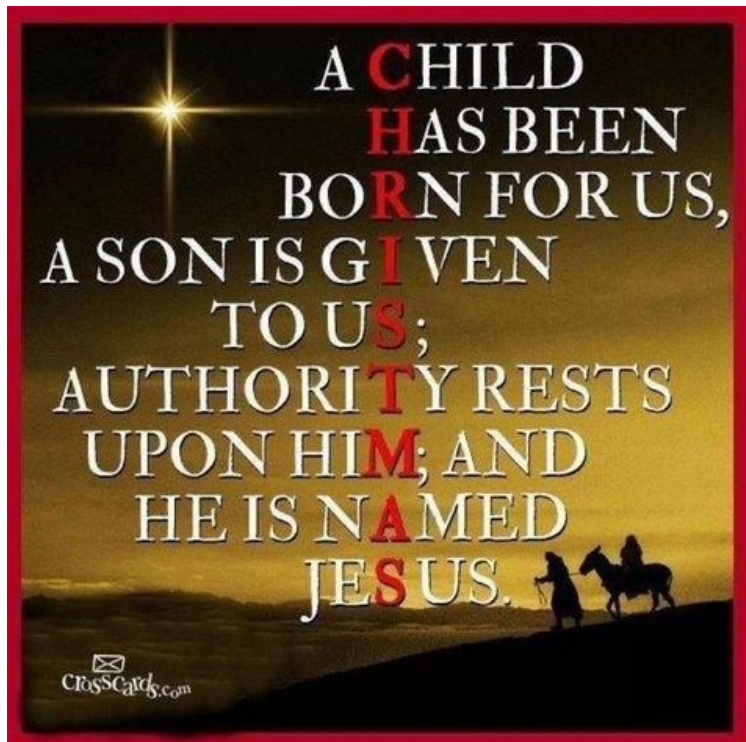
